- a) A member of the public raised concerns over the four water leaks at the junction of Aston Street and The croft which have been going on for over a month now. Having reported to Oxfordshire County Council and Thames Water who are not taking any form of responsibility jane Knight is following this up and will update as soon as possible.
- b) Concerns were raised about Orchard House with regards to the curved red brick entrance wall not being re installed. The planning application stated the existing boundary wall, red brick will remain but it appears a new wall has been build. Jane Imbush will speak to the planning officer tomorrow (Thursday 14th December) and express the villagers concerns over the wall not been re-instated to its original appearance.
