# 1. Minutes of the last meeting

## 2. Planning

- a. Low Ham (Upthorpe Farm)
  - i. For discussion by the PC at its meeting on 21st January.
  - ii. The SODC Housing Development Officer now requires the developers to plan for affordable housing, counting all four phases as one application.
  - iii. The Cook Trust believes there is a majority within the Astons in favour of affordable housing (CLP), but there is also a majority against excessive additional development. The two aren't mutually exclusive as those wanting to keep development within SODC's 5-10% growth protocol might want a proportion of what is built to be affordable.
  - iv. The meeting considered that Phase 4 is not within the settlement boundary.
  - v. Advice from consultants has been valuable.
- **b.** Also for discussion at the forthcoming PC meeting is a proposal from the owners of Ashbrook in The Croft to build a house in their garden. The plot is small, yet the proposed house would be large. In-fills have been rejected over the years.

## 3. Conservation Area Management Plan and Character Appraisal

**a. AD** will apply for listed status for the war memorial. She will investigate any necessary increase in insurance premium.

#### 4. Planning constraints within the Astons

**a.** The Environment Groups' tree survey should be ready in May. Otherwise, this project will take longer than originally thought.
